

BALLOT BY MAIL / FPCA INFORMATION

Absentee Ballot by Mail (ABBM) must be applied for annually. You may call our office on 361-621-1519 to request an application to be mailed to you or [click here](#) (External Link) to download one.

La solicitud de Voto en Ausencia por Correo (ABBM) debe solicitarse anualmente. Puede llamar a nuestra oficina al 361-621-1519 para solicitar el envío de una solicitud por correo.

Requirements to vote by mail:

- 65 years of age or older
- Disability -if a voter has a sickness or physical condition that prevents the voter from appearing at the polling place on election day without the likelihood of needing person assistance or of injuring the voter's health.
- Expected to give birth within three weeks before or after Election Day
- Expected absence from the county – must provide out of county address.
- Confinement in jail

Effective December 1, 2017, if an ABBM is faxed or emailed or an FPCA is faxed, then the applicant **must** submit the ORIGINAL application BY MAIL to the early voting clerk so that it is received no later than the **4th business day** after receiving the original ABBM or FPCA.
